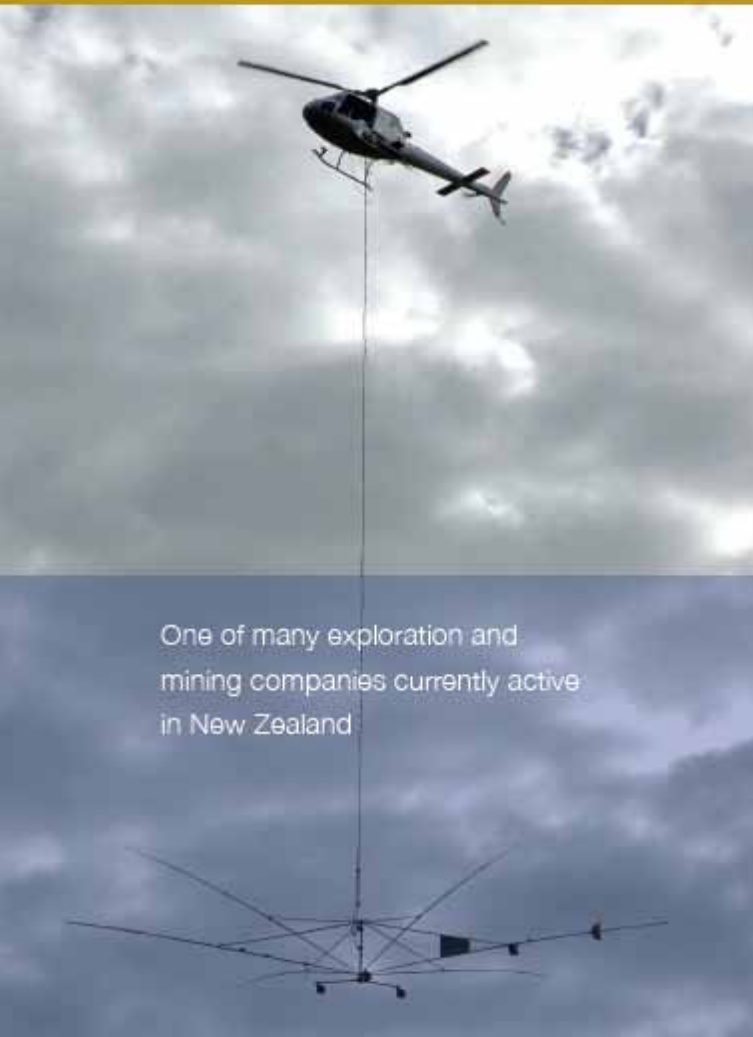

A modern drill rig is self-contained and has a small footprint

100mm drill core

Varied depth and/or angle

Up to several weeks at a site

Self-contained

Rehabilitated on completion

The Coromandel Peninsula contains areas of significant conservation and amenity value



A drill site is typically
10m x 10m

Disturbed areas are
restored to a condition
the same as, or better
than, before activities
began

Exploration drilling does not mean a mine will follow



Only one in a thousand exploration prospects becomes an operating mine

In the Hauraki district in the past 30 years only two mineable gold deposits have been become operational

1:1000
